Who May Apply

To apply, applicants must be

- A resident of Newfoundland and Labrador;
- Completed high school in 2017;
- Have an 80 per cent or greater average in their final two years of high school;
- Enrolled full-time for the Fall 2017 academic term at a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution; and,
- Must be a dependent of a member in good standing with their respective union.

Application Form

Applications shall be submitted on completion of the applicants graduating year of high school. Completed application forms must be submitted by October 13, 2017 and must include an official high school transcript of your final year marks. Applicants are asked to have two letters of reference sent on their behalf by a reference.

Scholarship Amount

NLBTC will award five (5) \$2000 university/trades entrance scholarships to a dependent of a member of one of the 16 NL Building Trades Unions.

Selection and Announcement of Winners

An independent selection committee is retained to review and evaluate all applications and identify the successful candidates for 2017.
